I WOULD LIKE TO START 1977 off with HOW TO STUDY FOR SIGHT CALLING.....

I feel that before you can be an effective Sight Caller YOU must have aquired alot of knowledge in certain areas....You should know where the call you have just given will take the dancers and into what formation they will end up in....Also when they have arrived at the new formation what calls are available to you from that formation, then depending upon your selection what will the new ending formation be....On and on the circle turns....Your ability to make creative and comfortable selections will determine your success as a sight caller not forgetting the ability to return the dancers to their proper partner and corner....On the next page I will have some practice material for you.....

# HOW TO PRACTICE YOUR SIGHT CALLING.

First have a list of the Callerlab Mainstream Basics and experimentals that you use...

Second, Take a sheet of paper and make the following list a heading with room under each heading for you to list calls.....

Normal lines Facing in
Normal lines facing out
Normal eight chain thru boxes.
Normal waves set up at the boxes. (parallel waves)
Double pass thru Formation
Normal Completed Double pass thru Formation
Trade by Formation
Columns set up from 1P-2P lines with a curlique.
Left Handed waves, set up from a Dixie Style to a wave.
Later on expand to include lines of two boys-two girls
Waves with boys facing in girls facing out.
boy-boy --girl-girl waves.....

NOW list from memory under each heading the basics that can be performed, then check the Callerlab list and see what you forgot....

NEXT: write out along side of each basic the ending formation....Example under the heading: NORMAL LINES FACING IN.....SQUARE THRU FOUR....ENDS IN A TRADE BY FORMATION.....

If you are unsure of your endings work them out with your checkers.....YOU WILL FIND THAT THIS WILL HELP YOU AS YOU START TO TRY SIGHT CALLING WITH LIVE DANCERS.....

# CALLERLAB QUARTERLY MAINSTREAM EXPERIMENTAL FOR JAN. - MARCH. EXTEND THE TAG. JIM DAVIS.

Extend the Tag is another position changing action that is a variation of the basic Tag the line and its fractional endings...Basically the figure will move us from one wave formation to another wave formation....From 1/4 tag formations, extend the tag will move us to a 1/2 tag or two parallel wave formation.....If we are in parallel waves and extend the tag will leave us in the 3/4 tag formation......

EXTEND THE TAG MEANS TO STEP AHEAD, IF FACING ANOTHER COUPLE, STEP INTO A RIGHT HANDED OCEAN WAVE....IF LEFT FACING OUT THEN REMAIN FACING OUT..... It is a simple idea but if not used carefully and with complete understanding it could cause some problems......NOTE it is possible to use the term extend the TAG when no tag was used to set up the waves....I find myself using EXTEND TO A WAVE when in the 1/4 tag formation and want the centers to extend the tag....I don't feel that it will stir up and problems and is helpful to the dancers at accept the fact that you want them to establish an ocean wave......

Heres where I started aquainting our mainstream dancers with Extend The Tag....

## MAINSTREAM EXPERIMENTALS.

TRACK 1. Dick Bayer, Michigan. TRACK I was born in controversy and somewhat lost in the shuffle with the popularity of Track II. I feel that the absence of worthwhile Mainstream material for experimental workshops that TRACK I is worthy of your giving it another look.... The action starts from the completed Double Pass Thru Formation.. TEACHING THE TRACKS I USE THE TANDUM PARTNER TRADE METHOD, That is to have the Trailing Boy place his hand on the shoulder of the lead Boy and the trailing girl do the same to the lead girl...Locked together in a Tandum formation you do a partner trade which brings us back to a Double Pass Thru Formation....For a Track I the lead couple will step into an ocean wave.....The set is then in the 1/4 Tag formation and certain popular calls such as Ping Pong circulate, chain Reaction can be called..... NOTE....If your starting set up is 1P-2P lines....Pass Thru....Wheel & Deel.... Double Pass Thru....Track I.....You are in the same set up as calling from a 1P-2P line...pass thru....wheel & deel....centers step to a wave..... DANCING EXAMPLES: 1P-2P.... PASS THRU....WHEEL & DEEL....DOUBLE PASS THRU.... TRACK I....CENTERS RECYCLE.... PASS THRU....LEFT ALLE....sd Box 1-4. PASS THRU....WHEEL & DEEL....DOUBLE PASS THRU....
TRACK I....CENTERS FAN THE TOP.... 1P-2P.... SQUARE THRU FOUR....SWING THRU.... GIRLS CIRCULATE....BOYS TRADE....BOYS RUN... TAG THE LINE....LADY GO LEFT GENTS GO RIGHT....LEFT ALLE. PASS THRU....WHEEL & DEEL....DOUBLE PASS THRU.... TRACK I....PING PONG CIRCULATE.... CENTERS SWING THRU....TURN THRU....LEFT ALLE.....box 1-4. Give Track I another try and perhaps it will fit into your workshop program.... TIE THE LINE....Dick Bayer Mich. The figure is a quick reaction idea that has two actions....From Lines Facing out....The ENDS of the line will Cross Fold then Roll to end facing each other....The centers of the line will do a partner tag, (face each other then pass thru) then split the outsides and run around one to end back in facing lines....The action becomes a technical zero. From a 1P-2P line....Pass Thru....Tie the Line, you end in a 4P-1P line ..... I'm reporting this figure as it has a certain type appeal. Could be a sleeper so let your workshop Dancers let you know how they THE VARIATION CROSS TIE THE LINE starts with the same action, the centers after doing the partner tag and stepping inbetween the outsiders will CROSS RUN to the far end.... **EXAMPLES:** 1P-2P.... PASS THRU....TIE THE LINE.... SLIDE THRU....SQUARE THRU 3/4...LEFT ALLE.. 1P-2P.... PASS THRU...BEND THE LINE.... PASS THRU....TIE THE LINE.... CROSSTRAIL...LEFT ALLE.... 1P-2P.... RIGHT & LEFT THRU....ROLLAWAY 1/2 SASHAY.... PASS THRU....TIE THE LINE.... SLIDE THRU....LEFT ALLE.....

#### ADVANCED WORKSHOP

All material reported in this section is aimed at the very experienced workshop dancer...You will be causing your dancers many minutes of frustration if you use this type of material at the mainstream level.....

SIDE TRACK.... Tim Scholl, Penn.

A position oriented figure that can be started from many formations, Double Pass Thru, Completed Double Pass Thru, Trade By, eight Chain Thru and columns...WOW. Lets learn the action from the COMPLETED DOUBLE PASS THRU FORMATION... Determine the leaders and Trailers....LEADERS make a 1/4 right face turn and Single File will promenade 1/4 around the outside of the set and individually face IN. The Trailers will make a 1/4 Left Face turn and single file promenade 1/4 of the way around the inside of the square then turn individually to face in...Ending in a Double Pass Thru Formation...

1P-2P....PASS THRU....WHEEL & DEEL....
DOUBLE PASS THRU....SIDE TRACK....
CENTERS PASS THRU....SWING THRU....
SCOOT BACK...GRAND RIGHT & LEFT....

From all formations listed above the key is first to determine leaders and trailers and to have the dancers know where the center of the set is for the Single File Promenade portion....

FROM THE TRADE BY FORMATION....ALL DANCERS ARE LEADERS...
FROM THE EIGHT CHAIN THRU FORMATION....ALL DANCERS ARE TRAILERS....
FROM COLUMNS....DETERMINE LEADERS AND TRAILERS BASED ON THE BOX
CIRCULATE FORMATIONS....LEADERS AND TRAILERS IN EACH BOX.....
FROM THE DOUBLE PASS THRU FORMATION....LEADERS & TRAILERS ARE OBVIOUS.

The action sounds simple but is quite challenging....You really have a THREE part action...The 1/4 turn, the single file promenade, and last the 1/4 turn to face the center.....You can break the action into fractions by calling Side Track 2/3.... Meaning to do the first two parts and ending inparallel ocean waves.....Our advanced W/S has found Side Track quite an interesting choreography puzzle.....

With REGRET I still notice some note services showing examples of figures using TOUCH 1/4 when a wave or Column is already established....There is a fine line when the call preceding the Touch command is an action call such as 8 Circulate. IF the circulate is complete at the time the Touch is called it is incorrect....HINGE would be the proper term for the 1/4 turn....IF however the command is given while the dancers are in motion then you have the fine line I'm talking about....After a swing thru the best way is a HINGE not Touch....

This month I have started a new section called "HOT POTATO"....I will "stick my neck out" and give my opinion on the subjects we are always talking about....This month it Potato" I wiil do my best.....

# BASIC CHOREOGRAPHY AND TEACHING HINTS.

The TEA CUP CHAIN has always held a certain facination for dancers and can be a tough call to teach...We have a SUPER teach for the Tea Cup and it has been several years since we have put it in the notes...So Here Goes.....

From a normal squared set, set the stage for learning the Tea Cup Chain by having all the ladies POINT at the Corner man and number him 1... Now have the ladies point at the opposite man and call him number 2... The man in the couple on the left is number 3 and your own partner is number 4....Repeat the numbering and tell the girls that they will visit each man in the numbered order, first i, then 2 etc..Tell the HEAD men that their function will be to send the ladies into the center of the set for a star action and the SIDE mans job will be to take the girls out of the star and send them to the man on their right...NOW, have the Side ladies leave the set, leaving only the Head ladies and the four men....Have the head ladies step to the center and make a two hand right hand star and turn the star 3/4 to end facing the Number 1 Man...Have the Side men reach out with the same hand as the lady is offering, the LEFT, and courtesy turn the lady and direct her over to the number 2 Man who will turn her by the Right and because he is a head man , he will put her back into the center for a left hand star one full turn and 1/4 more to end facing number 3 man....The side man number 3 will reach out with the right hand and turn the girl and send her over to number 4 who will for now courtesy turn her...REPEAT this action with only the Head Ladies active...I suggest a total of three times thru....NOW have the head ladies rest as the Side ladies join the set...Tell the Side ladies that they also start visiting the men in order...Extend your right hand to the number 1 man....The head men will turn the side ladies and then put them into the center for a left handed star one full turn and 1/4 more to end facing number 2 man...Number 2 man will courtesy turn her by the Right and send her to the right over to number 3 man....Number 3 man will turn her by the left and put her into the center

## TEACHING THE TEA CUP CHAIN (cont.)

right hand 3/4 star to end facing number four man who for now will courtesy turn her....REPEAT the action two more times for the side ladies and then have the head ladies join the square and work the action in total....As you review the total action keep reminding the girls to follow the order of visitation and for the men to remember their jobs, Head men put the girls into stars, Side men take them out and feed them over to the man on the right....LAST, here is an easy way to get them all started together.... Have the dancers WALK ALL AROUND THE LEFT HAND LADY.....TURN PARTNER BY THE LEFT...ALL THE WAY AROUND...HEAD LADIES CENTER FOR A TEA CUP CHAIN... SIDE LADIES TO THE RIGHT..... The last thing is to remember that they have learned the figure as heads or sides, if placed in the other position they will have real problems, PLEASE give the dancers the opportunity to walk thru the figure after the set has rotated heads and sides.....Go Get Them.....

#### MAINSTREAM LEVEL EXPERIMENTALS.

The lack of new experimental basics has led me to review a couple of really nice experimentals....CHECKMATE THE COLUMN and TRADE THE WAVE.....

CHECKMATE THE COLUMN.. We first reported Checkmate in 1975 on pages 28 and 37.

The figure has remained on Stan Burdicks Pulse Poll for a long time and I feel as do our dancers that it really has a place in the Mainstream Plus Clubs....Easily mastererd from all positions and the ending formation of a two face line lends itself to nice follow up calls such as Couples circulate, Ferris Wheel, Cross Fire, Tag the lines etc.....

THE STARTING ACTION IS FROM A COLUMN.....I suggest setting up from a 1P-2P line with a curlique or Touch 1/4.....Have the lead two dancers in the column walk single file around the adjacent dancers and walk to the far end of the line and Face IN....

The Trailing Two Dancers NOW will walk ahead single file past the on coming two, then once past each other face right and as a pair step ahead to form the end of the two face line facing out...I URGE THE FOLLOWING TEACHING HINT...ONCE THE THE TRAILING DANCERS HAVE WALKED PAST THE ON-COMING TWO AND HAVE FACED TO THE RIGHT HAVE THEM JOIN INSIDE HANDS AND STEP AHEAD TOGETHER.....When you get involved in all positions this will help as they won't walk out alone and transpose positions....

TRADE THE WAVE. With the Dixie Style becoming a popular Mainstream figure The Trade The Wave action which really fits into the Trade Family is a really handy basic at it takes the Left Hand wave set up by the Dixie Style and changes the dancers back in a normal wave right handed with the boys on the ends and the girls as centers..... THE ACTION OF TRADE THE WAVE.

From a Dixie Style Wave (or any wave) have the dancers look at who is facing the same direction as they are... Now have them lean forward and "Peek" at the one pring the same way..... Next have them step thru the wave and trade places with the refacing the same way as they are and reform the wave..... You can even clue the dance bit by saying "Take a Peek"....TRADE THE WAVE...... examples next page...

CROSSTRAIL Vs CROSSTRAIL THRU.....The only major difference is that the Crosstrail Thru includes the PASS THRU first then the crosstrailing action of the right hand person crossing to the left as the left hand person crosses behind them to the right..... | FEEL The easy way to use the two are as follows....WHEN COUPLES ARE FACING SUCH AS IN LINES OF FOUR THEN THE PROPER TERM IS CROSSTRAIL THRU. If the Lines are formed facing out such as lines set up from a square thru four from an eight chain thru box and you want the dancers to Crosstrails to the corner Then you useCROSSTRAIL without the Thru.....THE Only really BAD set up is if the caller uses Crosstrail from facing couples and wants the dancers to leave out the pass thru and to "cut across" one another... I feel this is POOR judgment and Poor usage of the Call.... Another phase of the Crosstrail HOT POTATO is where does the figure end and in what formation.....We all know that the call is used to get to a corner for a left allemande any tine we are out of sequence and with partner....WE REALLY should say Crosstrail Thru TO THE CORNER for a Left Alle....The action to turn to the corner or curve to the corner is really a "Fudge" but if the command is given in time and from constant usage the Dancers have come to accept this action....The Crosstrail Thru STOP....really ends with dancers facing out half sashayed. The same as if the did a rollaway 1/2 sashay then pass thru....Then we can addTo the Corner or Around One to a Line etc....Lets NOT GET SO TECHNICAL THAT THE Average Dancer is Confused BUT LETS ELIMINATE SUCH MIS-USAGE SUCH AS Heads Crosstrail Thru and a U turn back to mean the set is in a double pass thru formation.... The crosstrail Thru and U turn back for the Heads would leave the set squared up with the heads as if they had done a Right & Left Thru.....

Cross Side Track is a variation based on last months advanced W/S figure SIDE TRACK...
The experimental Side Track has really been getting the attention of callers in the advanced workshops and CROSS SIDE TRACK should add to the "Fun".....The action starts the same as the basic Side Track with the lead dancers making a 1/4 right face turn and the Trailing dancers turning 1/4 to the Left....Now the CROSS portion comes into effect as the dancers do the single file 1/4 promenade the inside dancers will cross to the outside as the outsiders cross to become the insiders, then all 1/4 turn to face the center of the set ending in a double pass thru formation.....The TIMING is equal for both the outside and inside pair as they do the 1/4 single file promenade portion and all dancers will arrive at the ending formation at the same time.....

## KEEP BUSY....Lee Kopman...New York.

An interesting Challenge Call that is properly named...The action is enough to keep you busy but quite smooth and flowing even though the variety of actions are stacked together....Our Advanced dancers found this one much more to their liking then most of the recent advanced experimentals...It has a personality and the dancers feel it....

ACTION starts from parallel two face lines...Our Teach is based upon normal two faced lines such as those set up from a Box 1-4...Swing Thru...Boys Run...COUPLES WILL Extend, This will form a two faced line thru the center....The centers of this two faced line will hinge and then the diamond formed in the center will flip.....(no diamond circ) This leaves the centers in an ocean wave with girls on the ends and boys as the centers.... The COUPLE left facing out will Wheel Across (couples Trade) to end standing behind one half of the ocean wave.....NOW the unusual part takes place.....The dancers in the wave will extend and the end of the wave, the girls will make a right about face....The dancers in the outsides as normal couples will have the Boys Walk (all the way across the set)

and the Girls Dodge to her left to end forming parallel ocean waves with boys facing out and girls facing in..... This last portion is different but easily mastered and seems to have some appeal or intrigue for the dancers......

Getting all the parts together will take a couple of times thru BUT you may be surprised that the RIGHT dancers will learn it easily and will like it......

With Regret 1 must comment on an advanced experimental published in two other Note Services as Positive Circulate or a name change to Butter Fly Circulate....These figures were sent to me by the author BUT WE FOUND some serious FLAWS in the choreography. Flaws that made the figure incorrect....I have written to the author and if we can get the figure to be properly set up then I will consider publishing it....The Flaw has to do with the Determination of who is the center of the Diamond formed in the middle of the formation... Enough said for now BUT I felt that I must say something about it as I'm sure many of you could have become confused by the situation.....

| BASIC CHOREOGRAPHY; BACKTRACK is a basic that is often looked at as a carry over from the early years of modern square dancing. I have noticed a weakness in many mainstream dancers when a backtrack is called. I feel that lack of usage is the reason. From a promenade position (basic skaters position) the dancers will make an about face turning toward your partner as you make the about face turn. NOTE If your area uses a promenade position other then the skaters you can be in trouble!!! EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP.....EASY MAINSTREAM...Relaxed dancing.

STAR THE ROUTE.....Don Williamson.. Tenn.

Don asks that the term ROUTE is pronounced as a rhyme with out, not root. To start the action the command Heads Right Hand Star The Route will get them started... The heads will right hand star 3/4 to meet the couple on their right with a Left hand star one full turn....Heads will meet back in the center of the set to star right 1/2 way to meet the other sides with a left hand star one full turn....Heads meet in the center for a right hand 3/4 star back to home or to the corner for a left alle.... The action times out at 32 beats so it fits the singing call breaks nicely......For the relaxed level dancers or for abreak in the "thinking hard" portions of our dance this will give your dancers the feeling of "really dancing".... A minimum of patter, only cues will add to the flavor.....GIVE IT A TRY...

## MAINSTREAM WORKSHOP LEVEL.

STRETCH RECYCLE.....Ron Schneider ... Fla.

The idea to "Stretch" your recycle is really a nice one that your mainstream dancers will find easy to learn as they are not really learning a new figure but using what they already know in a different manner.....Lets start with a get aquainted set up... as the figure can be used from two basic formations.....Heads Pass the ocean....This sets up the 1/4 tag formation of the wave thru the center of the facing in couples..... The STRETCH RECYCLE is aimed at the dancers in the ocean wave who will do a recycle action but extend or stretch the size of the action to end behind the couples facing in....The outside couples can step forward into the center to keep the stretch from getting to far..... suggest using this get aquainted with the stretch idea a couple of times then move to the two parallel ocean wave set up where the Stretch Recycle will have the set end up in a double pass thru formation....The end dancers facing out of the set along with the adjacent dancers will do normal recycles while the others, the ends of the wave facing in and their adjacent dancers will do the Stretch recycle to end in the far center position....Somewhat in a ferris wheel type ending..... NOTE...It is important that the dancers properly execute the recycle action...If the girls or centers of the wave are being "dragged"into position the figure is going to be un popular BUT if the centers of the wave dance their action as a turn and follow the ends of the wave then the figure REALLY is nice.....

I place this call in the advanced level area as it lends itself to being a "challenge" movement when broken down into fractions...You can stop the action at the 1/4, 1/2, 3/4 or full exchange with each spot giving you the creative choreographer quite a few challenging formations....The basic action starts from normal following diamonds with the center of the wave being declared as the leader of each Diamond....

The leader will lead the diamond toward the point of the opposite diamond the you can see, and walk around the outside of the other diamond as all dancers follow in behind in a figure 8 type walk to reform twin diamonds...The new diamonds will be left handed if star started from normal right hand formations...The dancers will end up occupying the same position in the new diamond...the dancers in the wave will be back in a wave centers as centers etc...points of the original diamond will be points.....It may take the dancers a time or two to "catch on" to the action but it is not difficult for dancers aquainted with diamonds.....

HOT POTATOES: WHEN IN AN OCEAN WAVE WHO IS YOUR PARTNER?

How do you designate the relationship of the dancers in a wave?. The acean wave is really a hand connected facing couples formation that is used as the choreography called dictates...At times we use the wave as alternately facing individuals and talk as ends and centers for figures such as circulates, at times we only pass thru the wave never stopping, only using it as recognition point....We arm turn the adjacent dancers from close ocean waves and we crosstrail thru from stretched out ocean waves....WE really get alot of flexibility out of the formation....In an ocean wave your partner is the dancer you would be standing next to if a pass thru were called, or the one you would turn if a right & left thru were called.....The dancer you are holding right hands with in a normal wave I designate as the ADJACENT dancer or your NEIGHBOR....These are terms I use when teaching or explaining a figure .....

I would like to comment on a couple of "Gimmick" basics that have been getting alot of attention in some note services.....Turn Over and Oh Yeah....Please, in this you gotta have a gimmick world, why these two....You can call Turn Over directionally and Oh Yeah has such terrible timing that can avoided if you directionally call ends trade...centers turn back....enough said......

The membership felt that there were many other more important subjects to aim the callerlab energy toward. The end result is that Callerlab will not enter into any form of direct assistance nor any head on collision with the National.. The convention did agree to fill out the plateau system of dance level identification. The Mainstream Plus 1 plateau was revised and a Plus 2 plateau was accepted for a one year trial. The basis for an Advanced and Challenge plateau was created with the acceptance of the concept. The actual lists will come about in July with the action of Callers involved in the advanced and challenge level calling. The Mainstream basics list will remain unchanged...No new basics were added to the list and none were dropped. The word Split was added to the circulate family but we had accepted the term "box" in the past and the two terms are really acceptable and used under different conditions....So along with the above information the Interest sessions from Contra and one night stands to Mainstream Choreo attracted large interested callers sharing ideas. A committee was hard at work all thru the convention creating a Callerlab Timing List. Many other activities were included in making the 1977 convention one we can all be proud of.... Next year the convention will be in St. Louis.... Time to plan to attend. Have you been calling three years for an average of once a week???Are you the kind of caller who feels that working together is the answer to problem solving?? Then CALLERLAB is for YOU....Find a member and see that he extends to you an invitation. If you are isolated and no one is in a position to invite you then write to me...

BASIC CHOREOGRAPHY: I have covered this area briefly in the past but it is such a practical and effective method of Sight Calling that I feel a little more depth into ISOLATED SIGHT is worth the time... The basic idea is to place the dancers into a group of four in which you can easily call a left alle. The Box 1-4 set up is a good place to start. You have the matched pair of dancers, the number four couple and the "mis matched" pair made up of the Number 1 man and the number 3 lady... Any time you have the matched pair on the outside of the set and the mismatched pair on the inside of the set in normal man-lady position you can left alle... It is quite easy to place you checkers into a Box 1-4 and begin to select action combinations that keep the four dancers together and easily sighted back to the desired set up for a left alle. I would like to expand upon the Isolated sight and the basic Box 1-4 grouping to show you how very flexible the system is.....Place your checkers on a large white sheet of paper, and in the Box 1-4 set up... Draw a pencil square around the group in question, the Number 4 couple and the #1 man & #3 lady.... Look at your mainstream basics list and select figures that can be called from the box 1-4 or a 1-4 wave which when the basic is completed the four dancers are back into the box drawn by the pencil.....

2. Place the checkers into a box 1-4 then star thru...Now draw a pencil box around the four isolated dancers....See how much action can be worked out from this isolated formation....

3. Place the checkers in a box 1-4...star thru...pass thru & bend the line. Draw a line aroundthe four dancers that make up the group..Notice that they are all in the same line....Select basic action figures that will keep the group in the line so when its time to "get out" all that is necessary is a bend the line and the group is facing and you can easily work to the proper left alle. set up... Note also from the

BASIC CHOREO....Cont.

line groupie that you are in that you can Pass Thru & Wheel & Deel, the groupie is in tact with the double pass thru formation or complete the double pass thru and the group is still together... From the completed double pass thru you can Centers in & Cast Off 3/4, Peel Off or even Cloverleaf and keep your group together....Work these and many others out with the checkers and see how the group can be kept together.

4. From the line groupie set up as in Number three call a Pass The Ocean.

Observe the four dancers in question and draw your pencil line around them....See how you can keep the action confined to the dancers on each half of the waves that are

made up of the "special four folks.....

5. From the line groupie call a curlique and observe that all four are in the same line, now call a circulate two position then observe the groupie.....
I feel I have given you lots to digest and work on.....Get started and you will find it possible to use most all the mainstream basics in Isolated Sight......

## CALLERLAB PLUS PLATEAUS.

For the dancers and callers interested in dancing above the Mainstream level the Plus Plateaus are the next two levels....The Plus plateau dancers should be very comfortable dancing at the mainstream level and be familiar with all the quarterly selections prior to getting involved in a workshop to reach the plus groups....Here are the basics in each catagory..

The possibility exists for the workshop to use these figures in the Standard dancer position or to expand into the All Position concept of dancing....

The stepping stones are now available for dancers to move into advanced level dancing on a steady and slow pace. The jump is no longer so large as to make the change very difficult. The problems come for the caller with the desire to have an all inclusive program....Not enough nights in the week!!!!

Last year we covered most of the plus 1 basics on a one a month basis. I plan to do the same with the Plus 2 list starting with....

EXPLODE THE WAVE... Explode the wave is an easily mastered variation of explode the line.....The dancers in the wave will all Step thru the wave(pass thru) then face the center of the set to extend right hands to the facing dancer and "pull" by, ending back to back...From parallel waves you end in lines facing out and from end to end waves you end in a trade by set up....From right hand waves the figure equals a 1/2 square thru...From left hand waves it equals a Left 1/2 Square Thru...

The experimental Crossfire seems like the best choice of the available experimentals
when considering the Mainstream Dancer. The action can easily be mastered and the
ability to use the figure from all positions is there but certainly not necessary for all
our dancers....The action starts from a Two Face Line.....The Teach is important so
establishthat the ends will Cross Fold (this is the same as a recycle ending for the ends)
after the ends have completed the cross fold then teach the centers their part...The
centers will trade then extend (step ahead) to join right hands with the awaiting dancer.
Have the dancers walk the action two or three times seperately then both starting their
action at the same time...Easily mastered.....From parallel two face lines you end in
columns and from end to end two face lines you end in parallel ocean waves.....
NOTE....It is important for the dancers to establish the two face line an the end of any
action such as a couples circulate or coordinate....The centers of the line should join
right hands to establish the two face line formation....This will assist their reaction

VIEWPOINT: Now that Callerlab has established a plateau system and with the possibility of selections from eight levels or divisions what are YOU doing to review the plateau your club best fits into? What are you doing about having the local Square Dance magazine relate to all the dancers in the area the names for the plateaus, such as Mainstream or Mainstream Plus I. Is the A.P.D. being shown where it best reflects upon the type of dance being called....The sooner we make every attempt to all use the same system the easier it will be for the dancers and after all thats what its all about. Lets make it possible for all the dancers to know what the various plateaus mean and why there are different levels of dancing...Why not review your dance program and with some effective club leaders select the title of the plateau that best tells the story for your club, then advertise your club dance with the appropriate label.

BASIC CHOREOGRAPHY: PEEL OFF is one of the Mainstream Basics that seems to be losing its popularity with callers. WHY? I'm not sure except it seems to me that callers are not finding much variety in the formations used prior to and following the use of a Peel Off. I would like to explore Peel Off this month in the hope that those of you who have dropped the figure will find a few ideas to create some interesting dance routines.

THE BASIC PEEL OFF formation comes from a completed Double Pass Thru set up. The ACTION has the lead dancers peel away from each other as they make an about face. This action leaves the center wide open for the Trailing pair to STEP FORWARD into the vacated positions then turn away from each other in a peeling motion as they also make an about face. ENDING FORMATION is a line of four facing in. It is very important that the body flow of all dancers is away from the adjacent person as the about face action is danced. This flow lends itself to follow with a bend the line, a tag the line or to remain in the original line established by the peel off.

For a variety in formations you can apply a Peel Off to the "Z" formation. That is the set up from an ocean wave and have the ends of the wave Fold...Leaving the set in the "Z". The Peel Off action from here follows the rules, the leaders about face away from the center leaving the middle open for the trailers to step forward into the vacating position then the centers about face turning away from the mid point leaving a two face line.....Here are some dancing examples from both positions:

MAINSTREAM PLUS EXPERIMENTAL...WALK OUT TO A WAVE...Lee Kopman.

Walk Out To a Wave came out last summer and because of a difficult "teach" it fell into the challenge level.... have found an easy way of presenting the action and I'm sure you will find it an easy Mainstream Workshop Call... The figure takes a normal column and ends in two normal parallel ocean waves....

Set up your columns from a 1P-2P line with a Touch 1/4... Divide the column into two modules, two sets of two one as the leader the other as the follower... The dancers should recognize if they are the leader or the follower... Action is to all eight circulate double... Then the LEADER in each module, the girls, right about face to join right hands with the trailing boy dancer who veers slightly to the left to become the ends of the wave as the girls become the centers.... About the second or third walk will allow the dancers to move from the double circulate into the ocean wave..... Easily learned and it times well with really no complications.....

The reason for the double circulate is for motion to flow into the creation of the wave.

## CALLERLAB MAINSTREAM PLUS II PLATEAU.

Last month we listed the calls making up this plateau and each month we will give a little attention to one of the calls on the list....

RELAY THE DEUCY.... An action figure that flows really great and is always a Big Zero ..... like the action of Relay the Deucy and so will your dancers once they master the action....

BASIC TEACHING FORMATION ... BOX 1-4... OCEAN WAVE.....

Present the call in three segments:

1. All dancers turn by the right 1/2....centers by the left 3/4....Ends of the wave then circulate 1/2 to establish a six hand wave thru the center and two left over dancers along side....

2. The wave of six, swing thru....boy on the end of the six hand wave will vacate the position by stepping ahead, turning the corner and circulating one position...as soon as he vacates the end spot the leftover girl will step up and take his place as the end of the six hand wave....

3. The last segment is to have all dancers in the six hand wave turn right 1/2 and the girls then turn left 3/4 as the boys progress ahead to become the ends of the forming ocean wave....

I teach the figure in the above segments having a hesitation at each spot the first two times thru then the third time work for continous movement....NOTE There is a different dancer action when the Sides square thru four to set up the waves at a sides Box 1-4....So recognize this when presenting the figure.....
RELAY THE DEUCY can be called from any parallel ocean wave set up and it ALWAYS will be a zero.... I suggest the standard ocean wave for a while and you can use it any time parallel ocean waves are set up and then continue your basic theme.....

BOX 1-4...RELAY THE DEUCY....GIRLS RUN....
BEND THE LINE...LEFT ALLE....

## MAINSTREAM PLUS II WORKSHOP.....TRADE THE WAVE.

Trade The Wave is a very useful call and in my opinion has the qualities to be a Mainstream call.... Used most easily to change a left hand wave into a right hand wave, Trade The Wave will do the reverse, change a right hand wave into a left handed wave. The TEACH...From any wave formation have the dancers lean forward and "Peek" at the dancer facing the same direction... The action has the dancers stepping thru the wave and trading places with the dancer facing the same direction and then reforming the ocean wave. I like to teach the figure from a left handed wave set up by a dixie style to a wave then use the trade the wave to return to a normal wave.... You can give the dancers a crutch by saying "Take a Peek..Trade The Wave" until the reaction becomes automatic.... The Boys, meanwhile, will single file move ahead to a 1/2 Tag Position then Trade & Roll to end as the leaders in the ending formation of the Double Pass Thru Set Up... CAUTION. The two trouble spots are in the starting action of the Boys Running while the Girls Partner Tag, and then be sure the girls step forward as the do their phantom Wheel & Deel to clear out the center of the set to allow the boys room to smoothly complete their action.... The selections made by Al Brundage and the Quarterly Experimental Committee are presented to you for review and the committee hopes that the Callerlab policy of waiting until July 1 to present the figure will be adhered to by all callers.... Follow Your Neighbor and its popular variation Follow Your Neighbor & Spread are not new calls, in fact they have also been recently placed into a Plus level of dancing....The figures have been very popular in many areas of the country with experienced Mainstream dancers so I feel the same as the committee that it is time to explore the figure across the nation and find out if it really is a Mainstream call....or if it proves out that it belongs in a plus grouping.....Note that the variation has been more popular then the root call because it ends back into normal ocean waves.... I find also that relating the figure to Scoot Back helps the dancers accept the action.... BASIC TEACHING POSITION.....BOX 1-4....TOUCH 1/4.....An ocean wave with boys facing in and girls facing out..... THE ACTION OF FOLLOW YOUR NEIGHBOR.... Boys will step forward and meet with right hands and turn 3/4...(cast off 3/4) to end as centers of a left hand ocean wave... Girls will run right into the vacating adjacent position then 1/4 right face turn (roll) to end as the ends of the left hand wave....Note the original adjacent dancers in the right hand wave with boys facing in & girls facing out will end up holding left hands... CHECKMATE THE COLUMN......This month in our get aquainted with the Plus II catagory I have seleceted Checkmate...A nice flowing and useful action which starts in columns and ends in a two face line. Checkmate is easily adapted to the A.P.D. STARTING FORMATION.....From columns..... THE ACTION....The lead two dancers in each column, (the leader and the dancer right behind the leader) will walk single file around the adjacent column and walk single file to the "foot" of the column, then turn to face in.....The Trailing two dancers in the column will single file walk ahead past the on coming two (like a tag) then face right and as a couple step ahead to form the two face line...The KEY to the action is for the trailing couple to walk past the oncoming two and as they Face Right will JOIN INSIDE HANDS as theyextend to become the facing out couple in the two face line..... Viewpoint: Our Deepestsympathy to Ann King. The passing of Jay King will be felt by by all he touched thru his notes for callers and other publications....

WITH Three Years to experiment, Has the Callerlab Mainstream List been effective??? I feel it is a great program and has done wonders to bring Square Dancing back to a point where we can visit clubs and feel comfortable with the knowledge that we know the necessary calls....How do the Callers and dancers still in the class programs Feel? Does it take to long to learn how to dance?? Is there to much to cover?? DO WE spend to much time learning new figures and not enough time learning how to DANCE...

In reviewing the Callerlab list I feel there is a possible opportunity to limit the teaching during the first season to the extended basics section (54) and allow for a club program to develop at this plateau. Dancers wishing to go ahead into the Mainstream of dancing would be provided this opportunity at the start of the second season of dancing. Many folks find that they don't have the time to devote to Square Dancing that is required to "Keep Up" and they are forced to drop out....The extended level club would provide a place for these folks to continue Square Dancing as no other basics are required above the graduation level....Do you have folks who because of jobs. age etc would enjoy such a program? Do you have such a program now???What are you thoughts....I would greatly appreciate hearing from you as Callerlab is interested in the problem and perhaps we can get some action started toward this goal.....

The introduction of LEFT HANDED action figures presents for all dancers a new concept or challenge...Left Handed figures will expand your dancers appreciation of what can be done with Basics.... urge going slowly and with all Left Handed figures start by saying WITH A LEFT...Left Swing Thru etc..... The popularity of the Dixie Style to an ocean wave lends itself to the use of lefthanded figures as the Left Handed wave is established by the Dixie Style....

Once this is planted in your mind you can use on the third hand figures most any place in your choreo.....Lets show a simple way for an example.....The simple zero... Swing Thru Boys Run....Wheel & Deel is used by all.....You can add a little spice by using the following....Swing thru...boys run...1/2 Tag-Trade & Roll (this is the right & left thru) now the Square Thru But on the third hand.... Swing Thru.... boys run.... Wheel & Deel....Zero....Remember First call a Right & Left Thru and then Square Thru on the Third Hand and you in reality are starting from scratch.....NOTE...When actually calling figures a right & left thru then a square thru is POOR choreography as the men have their hands tied up behind a girls back from the courtesy turn and to bring it out for the square thru is not real smooth....So think of equivalents of right & Left thru..... Some Choreo Ideas. 1P-2P....RIGHT & LEFT THRU....SLIDE THRU.... SQUARE THRU..ON THE THIRD HAND....SPIN CHAIN-THRU....GIRLS CIRC DOU-BLE...BOYS RUN...BEND THE LINE.... How are your Dancers doing with Follow Your Neighbor....? I feel it is a good choice for a quarterly selection and it proves that many of our older creations are better dancing figures then the current crop of experimentals.... Last month we spent alot of time with the "neighbors" so if your groups have need for additional review check the July notes..... FOR YOUR MAINSTREAM PLUS TWO GROUPS here is a nice way of setting up Diamonds with a Follow Your Neighbor & Spread....

ADVANCED EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP.....TOUCH OF CLASS....Lee Kopman.

Touch of Class is for the all position experienced dancer....PLEASE Don't use this experimental with your Mainstream Dancers..... Touch of Class is best taught from parallel ocean waves with the boys facing in and the girls facing out...Set up this position from a box 1-4 with a curlique.....For the teach, have the girls see who is the girl in the center of the wave and which girl is on the end....Tell the center girl that she will run right into the soon to be vacated adjacent position while the end girl will cross run into the far center position....this will place the girls as a couple facing in while the four boys step forward a form an ocean wave in the center. The action continues by telling the end boys in the wave to observe where the girls are standing, the end boys will lead a recycle type action having the centers fold and follow the end boys into the position the girls now occupy as the girls will couples circulate one position....Ending formation is a two face line with boys facing in and the girls looking out.... THE only HANG UP in the action comes with the boys in the wave... The center boysmust Fold and Follow or at least Turn and Follow....You will need to make a point of this..... The Figure has been well received by the advanced group and they are dancing it nicely when not rushed......You can call Touch Of Class with the girls facing in and the boys facing out and then into all ocean waves....

I have accepted the position as Workshop editor for Square Dancing and we are looking for good smooth material to be published in the workshop section.... Please submit your dances to Ken Kernen, 462 No. Robertson Blvd. Los Angeles, Calif. 90048... PLEASE place a label on each dance to let me know the following information... IS the dance made up of mainstream basics or quarterly experimentals or experimentals... Is the dance standard position or A.P.D.... Let me know if one figure is central theme so we can feature "scoot back" dances on a single page...

The ALL POSITION DANCE CONCEPT has created alot of conversation...In reality it is nothing new, years ago we called it "position dancing".....How does it fit into your dance program?...A.P.D. is not necessary for a successful dance program...Most dancers like dancing the role they really are, a Man or a Lady....If your program is made up of dancers who attend twice a month and thats all the square dancing they have time for then a heavy A.P.D. program will be very difficult for them. If you have a group who like to try unusual formations and situations then the All Position Dance program can provide you and the dancer with lots of "challenge". The big question is to what extent should A.P.D. be part of the beginners program....The callerlab program calls for a 41 week lesson program, IF you can run 41 weeks then there is time to develop a basic understanding of A.P.D.....If you try to complete the callerlab program in 30 weeks then there is no time available for A.P.D. Lets face it to do it right it takes 40 weeks to cover the program we call Mainstream....Don't have 40 weeks then why not stop at the extended level and form a club for them..... A.P.D. means that you will accept 1/2 sashayed positioning for many couples figures as well as reaction to four boys or four girls in action.... With Mainstream Dancers my feelings are that A.P.D. can be used very sparingly but can add a bit of variety and "spice" to the program....Like spice a little goes a long way....

BASIC CHOREOGRAPHY: I would like to spend a few minutes with some "TRADES".

We have many plaves where the term trade is used, ends, centers, boys, girls, partner trade. The following dance examples will provide you with some Trade Material.....

### "ANYTHING" EXPLOSION.....Several Callers.

The evolution of this call is interesting, the call is in two parts, the "anything" is any figure or combination of calls that end in a column, and the explosion follows.... The explosion action from a standard column is as follows....The lead dancer, a girl in a normal column will stand pat...the boy who is second in the column will step up to the outside of the girl in front to form a couple....The third person a girl will step ahead and trade with the girl from the other column...The last boy in the column will step out to the outside of the girl in front of him .... Now the action continues with the two face line in the center extending as the lead couple does a couples trade or wheel across to end with the set in parallel two face lines..... The explosion action is the same as "solar" circulate which was an experimental idea about a year ago that was lost in the shuffle..... I feel it is the combination of the two calls that seems to have caught thedancers fancy... They are still getting two distinct calls but they are tied together with good flow and comfortable dancing.....Calls that can set up the column are Ah So...Cross Fire... Curlique...1/2 Tag the Line....Touch 1/4.... Why explosion not solar circulate??? I'm thinking that thefact that the action follows another so closely yet has an element of surprise with the variety of ways to set up the column has as much to do with it as any... Try it and see what your dancers think......

# CHASE & HINGE.....Ron Schneider..... Mainstream Plus. Experimental

Rons' idea starts with couples back to back and has a similar starting flow as a Chase Right....For Your Teach I suggest normal 1P-2P lines....Pass Thru....Have the Girls make an about face to the right then all will split circulate once and 1/2,,...The boys thru the center will Hinge to end as centers of a two face line as the girls end up as the ends of the two face line..... You will find that dancers familiar with chase right and the use of hinges will pick up the idea quickly....Works well with 1/2 sashayed lines facing out as well.....Can be called directionally but with a loss of flow into the ending two face line..... Examples on the next page.....

Are you busy teaching figures and square dance terms to your class members without giving them the opportunity to learn about proper styling, proper timing and proper attitudes toward Square Dancing...Do your dancers understand the working together of the musical beat and the steps they take while moving thru a basic figure? Show them the importance of understanding that it takes a certain number of steps to complete a particular basic and the music will count out those steps for you....Lets put the music and the action together and place the emphasis on DANCING TO THE MUSIC....

BASIC CHOREOGRAPHY: This month I would like to cover two areas...One is a series of transitions from Box 1-4 to a 1P-2P line. Second some Left Handed Combinations used to aquaint your dancers with the variety of action that is available by setting up left handed action.....

BOYS TRADE....LEFT SWING THRU.....GIRLS TRADE.... GIRLS RUN...BEND THE LINE...LEFT ALLE... 1P-2P... 1P-2P....LEFT TOUCH 1/4....8 CIRCULATE....GIRLS RUN...LEFT ALLE. If you plan to use the above dances "cold Turkey PLEASE be sure that your group feels comfortable with the all position concept.....Some of the dancers will be called upon to square thru 1/2 sashayed, some to swing thru or Spin The Top while 1/2 sashayed and it could present some problems if you don't take the time to set up the success process.....From this basic formation you should be able to develop lots of interesting combinations that will provide interesting choreo based upon the MAINSTREAM OF DANCING......

### EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP.....SUITABLE FOR PLUS II and Above...

IN STEP....(out Step) Ron Schneider..... TN STEP starts from Two Face Lines....The ends of the line will "Bend" that is to step forward and face the center of the set...From normal two face lines the ends will always step forward and face right or toward the center of the set. will hinge, then extend to form a wave with the awaiting ends.....The action is quick but all forward..... Note the ending formation of an ocean wave is the same as having called a 1/2 tag the line.....Our workshop group thought the figure added a bit of variety to two face line action as was worthy of presentation for your exploration. Note...The action works very well after a normal swing thru...Tell the boys to Run...IN STEP.....Their run right and then In Step action fits together real well.... BOX 1-4....SWING THRU....BOYS RUN..IN STEP... SCOOT BACK....BOYS RUN....SLIDE THRU....LEFT ALLE. Box 1-4...Zero BOX 1-4....SWING THRU....BOYS RUN....COUPLES CIRCULATE.... IN STEP....FOLLOW YOUR NEIGHBOR & SPREAD.... GIRLS TRADE....RECYCLE.... PASS THRU...TRADE BY...LEFT ALLE...Box 1-4. Pitch starts any time you can determine a lead couple and a following couple....On the call Pitch....The lead couple will make a right about face, circulate to the next position and always 1/4 RIGHT....The trailers will circulate into the next position and accept the directional rt, left, in or out call.....Strictly advanced and challenge level workshop. Leaves lots of possible endings from waves to columns to two face lines....

  NOTE....I see the experienced Mainstream Dancer as one who is aquainted with the Callerlab Quarterly Workshop selections....

- The Mainstream Plus II The Plus Programs provide for the experienced enthusastic Dancers who dance quite frequently and desire additional choreography.

The above programs will provide for the majority of all square dancers, IF we only use them effectively and with good judgement... We seem to Skip over 1 & 2 and jump into the Mainstream program without a good basic foundation or the opportunity to enjoy the primary purpose of the activity....RECREATION.....

This is the last issue for 1977.... I hope that you have found the notes to be helpful, useful and interesting. Our 1978 notes will be printed and the optional Advanced Supplement will allow the Notes For Callers to place full emphasis upon the Mainstream Programs as outlined above.... The Advanced supplement will contain drill material aimed at the Advanced Program as well as experimentals that fit into that level of dancing....

BASIC CHOREOGRAPHY: With the popular usage of 1/2 Tag-Trade & Roll we have noted that most dancers are responding to 1/2 Tag figures much better then several years ago BUT when you call a TAG THE LINE many dancers are careless about passing by the on-coming dancers completely.... would like to suggest that we use more Tag figures and help our dancers ....

## A REVIEW OF THE EXPERIMENTAL DANCE PROGRAM FOR THE YEAR 1977....

Good experimentals were extremely scarce in 1977. Very few ideas came from the choreographers that had real Mainstream potential. This is brought to center ring by the Callerlab Mainstream Quarterly selection committee. Only four selections were made during 1977 and only one Crossfire, was rather new, Extend and Follow Your Neighbor along with Follow Your Neighbor & Spread are old calls in for a second look.....

As expected, the majority of experimentals seemed best suited for the Plus plateau and on up into the advanced level.....Several caught on pretty fast and have gained universal acceptance..... By Golly and Stretch Recycle seem to be the most used by Callers across the country.....HERE ARE MY PICKS FOR THE YEAR:

From Completed Double Pass Thru Formation The ACtion starts....The Lead Couple will Crosstrail and turn back ending as the ends of a line while the trailing couple does a tight crosstrail and turn back to end as the centers of the line then all touch 1/4 with the facing dancer to end in a column....

NOTE...We experimented with the same ending formation BUT used Partner trades to do what the crosstrail u turn back accomplishes and found the action easier to teach and less traffic problems....Try it and see which way you like best, if at all, and let me hear from you....
